1) **AIS and Office of Institutional Effectiveness Updates** (*James Hardin*)

More than 30 COE programs submitted reports to UA's Office of Institutional Effectiveness by the Feb. 15th deadline via LiveText AIS. Those reports are currently being reviewed, and are expected to be finished in early May. Each program will be able to review the results in LiveText AIS once the process is complete.

2) **edTPA update** (*Shari Gilbert*)

Mrs. Shari Gilbert received edTPA scores for the spring candidates while at the Southeastern Regional edTPA conference. Last semester, the weekly edTPA training sessions were voluntary for teacher interns. Although the overall passing rate last fall was only 78%, all interns who attended four or more sessions performed extremely well. Consequently, this semester the COE required teacher interns to attend at least three edTPA Academy Sessions. As a result of the mandatory training and the team effort within courses, our passing rate this semester has dramatically improved to 93%, which is higher than the national average, including states in which edTPA is already consequential.

3) **Dispositions Rubric Revisions** (*Liza Wilson*)

At the last COE's Assessment meeting, groups spent time speaking about different degree levels and consideration where students should be at the end of their coursework and thinking through where students would be at each level. The Assessment Committee decided that each degree would have its own rubric. Dr. Wilson divided the committee into 4 different groups to compose disposition. The task of each group was to identify , target, and to develop rubrics based on the grid. The 4 various groups are listed below:

1. Diversity
2. Fairness and Equity
3. Collaboration
4. Reflective Stance for Professional Practice

Dr. Wilson asked each group to turn in what they have to Ms. House and she will format and send to each committee member.
