Assessment Committee Minutes

1. Assessment Spotlight

Diversity Resource—Drs. Cailin Kerch and Sheunghyun Yeo

Cailin Kerch and Sheunghyun Yeo spoke about the diversity resource that the Elementary Education program created and has been using the past several months. They created a space that examines what kind of diversity and inclusion concepts are being covered, what reading topics are happening in different courses, and what is missing.

2. Approval of March Minutes

3. Portfolio and Dispositions Results Overview

The Assessment Team is preparing to write the CAEP annual report; since we are in the second year of using the new assessment process, we are looking at how that process is going. Portfolio and disposition data was pulled from all disposition and InTASC standards. James Hardin gave a glimpse of the data collected from these standards and noted that progression is being made by each checkpoint at each degree level.

4. CAEP Annual Report Update

Once the report is completed, a public display will be created and will be available to anyone to review. She screen-shared the results from the five case-study observations that took place pre-COVID using the eleot data. She showed the areas in which the completers did well and the areas that could use improvement. Principals were also interviewed as part of the case study regarding the candidate's impact on P-12 student learning, and to see what they desire from the COE in terms of the teachers they hire.
